NOTE: If you pick up your ball and let your partner finish out the hole, your score CANNOT be used for the team score. You should record your score with an "X" by it so there is no question about the team score for that hole.

Scores for 4-ball can and should be recorded for your handicap. When picking up your ball on any hole, you should take your score at the time and add strokes to it for:

- What you think you would have scored, ie: you lie 6 before putting with a short putt, add 1 stroke for a 7. If lie is 6 with a long putt, you might add 2 strokes for an 8.
- Always mark an "X" by your score when you do not hole the ball so that it cannot be used for your team score. Use of such a score will result in disqualification.
- One player on each team MUST hole out for a legal score to be recorded.
