Notice to Competitors



FORM OF PLAY - SCRAMBLE: Each player on a team plays a tee shot. The team then selects which ball it wishes to play for the second shot with each golfer playing from that spot. Each ball must be played from within one clublength of the original spot, no nearer the hole and from the same area of the course (Bunker, Penalty Area, Teeing Area, Putting Green or General Area). This continues for all shots until the ball is holed. The hole is completed once the ball is holed. Players are cautioned NOT to tap in short putts if the partner has not played.

The competition within each Flight is GROSS SCORE. There is an OVERALL NET competition across the entire field. As prescribed by the World Handicap System, 35% of the lower course handicap and 15% of the higher course handicap will be used to calculate the Team Course Handicap.

PLAYOFF: Ties for all prizes will be broken by a scorecard playoff.

FLIGHTS: The field will be flighted after the registration deadline, and teams will be assigned to a flight based on the lowest Handicap Index® of the two team members as of April 30th.

TEES: The field will be playing from **RED MGA tee markers** which will be approximately 5,600 yards.

DIGITAL SCORING: Scoring will be kept using the **Golf Genius app**. Each team will be the marker for the other team and have the responsibility of keeping score using the app. Players will receive an email and text message with their GGID included. In addition, you may ask questions about using the app and getting your GGID at Registration prior to you starting your round.

PACE OF PLAY: Groups must remain in position with the group immediately in front of it. If they fail to do so, they may be **WARNED** and expected to regain their position. If a group fails to do so, they may be timed. Any player taking more than **40 seconds** to play a stroke may result in the TEAM incurring a penalty. Thank you in advance for maintaining your position on the course!

FACILITIES: The practice areas and clubhouse will be open at 7:00 AM. There will be range balls available on the range when you arrive.

FOOD & DRINK: Each player will receive **ONE DRINK TICKET** (good for any beverage) at the conclusion of their round. In addition, Oak Glen will have the following menu available during the day:

1. Breakfast Sandwich & Coffee - \$5 combo meal (7-10a)
2. Off the Grill Cheeseburger & chips - \$10 (11a-4p)
3. Chicken Caesar Wrap w/side - \$10 (all day)
4. Hot dogs & Brats - \$4.50 (all day)
5. Ham & Turkey sandwiches - \$7 (all day)
6. Full bar service (Beer, Wine, Cocktails) throughout the day

MGA DRESS CODE: For all MGA competitions, players must be neat in appearance with respect to personal grooming and clothing. All entrants are required to wear appropriate golf attire as defined by the host club and/or the MGA. Short shorts, athletic shorts, tennis shorts, denim, tank tops, T-shirts and sweats are not acceptable. The committee will decide whether this requirement has been met and will withdraw the entry of any player not complying with the policy.

REGISTRATION: A Registration Table will open 1.5 hours before each shotgun in the cart staging area. When you arrive please check-in at registration to receive your information.
