As a tournament player, you are responsible for knowing the Rules of Golf. We will discuss the things you need to know the most when playing in a tournament (such as relief options and how to proceed under 3-3), plus you can ask questions and see live demonstrations. It will be geared to the *player* and not the *official*.
