

**MINNESOTA GOLF ASSOCIATION'S
TWO-DAY RULES AND OFFICIATING WORKSHOP**

Purpose: This workshop is designed for those persons who have a good working knowledge of the rules but would like to improve. While this class is more advanced than the **One-Day Rules Workshop**, it is not intended to be equal to the *USGA/PGA Rules Workshops*. Discussion of the new and revised decisions will occur within the scope of the class.

Who Should Attend: Any person wanting to go beyond basic rules knowledge or wishing to become more involved in the officiating of championship events.

Eligibility: The class is designed for persons who have attended an *MGA Rules Workshop* or a *USGA/PGA Rules Workshop*. Space is limited to **80** attendees. Applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.

Continuing Education: PGA Members receive fourteen (14) CE hours. Other golf industry professionals should check with their respective organizations to see if continuing education credit is available.
