NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

- Registration & Check-in begins 1 ½ hours prior to shotgun start.
- RANGE BALLS ARE NOT AVAILABLE or INCLUDED at Red Wing.
- Instructions by your site captain are made 15 mins prior to start.
 Please be in your carts or near the site captain, ready to go.

Shotgun starts promptly at time stated above

Format: 18-Holes of Individual Stroke Play, Stableford Points

<u>Score Card Instructions</u>: Exchange your official scorecard with another player in your group before you play your first hole. Please return scorecards as quickly as possible, filled out completely and

signed by both the player and the marker. Players - please review and double-check all of your points and score before signing your card.

<u>Division</u>: Senior (55+) or Master (65+) is determined by your birth date as of May 1 of the current year for prizes

and performance points. Please check that your division designation is correct on your scorecard.

Pace of Play:

BE SURE TO KEEP UP WITH THE GROUP IN FRONT OF YOU. If you do fall behind, speed up your play until you are back in pace with the group ahead of you. If the site captain asks your group to get back into position by skipping a hole, you must do this and take zero points on that skipped hole.

<u>Close of Competition</u>: You have agreed to play and return your scorecard as quickly as possible. No scorecards will be accepted after results and prizes are announced.

Record gross score next to

player's name and deduct

strokes on indicated holes

points by referring to point

values shown in above box.

Determine stableford

for net score.

<u>Tees</u>: Yardage for Super Senior events will be 6000-6200 yards.

Tees to be played will be announced during the site captain instructions.

<u>Food</u>: Food will always be available at the host sites. If there is anything different or a special meal deal available we will communicate that to you.

Local Rules: You will be given a local rules sheet when you check in at registration.

These are the rules to be followed for the event, not the rules printed on the host club's scorecard.

<u>Rule 7–Practice</u>: Before the round you are allowed to practice putt only (no chipping or other shots) on greens on the course before the shotgun start. During play the <u>no practice putting rule is in effect.</u> Penalty of 2 strokes, which is applied to the next hole played.

Shaded hole designates

your starting tee box.

<u>Prizes:</u> Awards will be announced as quickly as possible so that you may get pro shop merchandise before you leave. Please give the scorers space and time to determine the winners.

<u>Handicaps</u>: Your handicap index from the revision closest to the event date will be used except if the revision date is too close to the event not allowing time to print scorecards. The revision prior will be used in that case.

Cap Pick Up: Remember to pick up your cap at the registration area. We will record when you have received it.

GHIN Posting: This is a Tournament Score Competition; all scores will be posted to your handicap record by the MGA within the following week.

<u>Inclement Weather:</u> Senior Tour events are held as scheduled rain or shine. Please show up to the host site on time unless notified by the MGA beforehand with a change.


NO DRIVING RANGE

Stableford Points:

1 Point = Bogey 4 Points = Eagle 2 Points = Par 5 Points = Dbl. Eagle

3 Points = Birdie
