

Notice to Competitors

MWGA 4-Ball

June 21-22, 2016

Somerby GC

Play is governed by the USGA rules of golf, MWGA local rules and conditions, and this notice

- Tee markers:** There are two sets of tees for this championship. Play is from the **blue** MWGA tee markers for the championship flight and from the **white** MWGA tee markers for players in all other flights.
- Yardage Markers:** Sprinkler heads are marked. Also, on cart path 100/150/200.
- Hole Locations:** Refer to hole location sheet.
- Out of Bounds:** Defined by white stakes.
- Water Hazards:** Water hazards are *identified* by yellow stakes and *defined* by yellow lines. A “drop zone” has been established on #14 that may be used as an additional option under Rule 26-1 for a ball that last crossed the **yellow** line. This may **not** be used for a ball that last crossed the lateral water hazard-**red line**.
- Lateral Water Hazards:** Lateral water hazards are *identified* by red stakes and *defined* by red lines.
- Ground Under Repair:** White lined areas. Relief is **mandatory** for any ball that lies in a flower bed.
- Obstructions:** All cart paths that are artificially surfaced and the worn areas that are adjacent to the cart paths. Refer to Rule 24 for relief procedure.
- Rakes:** Leave rakes ***outside of*** the bunkers.
- Rest Areas:** Building on each 9 that may be accessed after #2, #5, #10 & #14.
- Drinking Water:** Water is available on many of the tees.
- Decisions On Ties:** Any ties other than in the championship flight will be settled as the USGA recommends. See Appendix I of the Rules of Golf. If a tie still remains, the winner will be determined by a coin flip. The championship flight shall have a 3 hole play-off on holes #16, #17 & #18. If the tie remains, then a hole-by-hole play-off starting on #16 until settled.

Severe Weather Course Evacuation Plan

Signals

One (1) long blast = Discontinue Play *immediately*
Two (2) short blasts = Resume play
Three (3) short blasts = Discontinue Play for non-dangerous situation.

In the event of severe weather, go to the clubhouse or one of the rest areas. If a player believes she is in danger from lightning, she may discontinue play *without* permission from the Committee.
