Local Rules & Information

- TEES: Players', Mid-Players', and Senior Players' Divisions will play from the Blue tees (approx: 6475 yards).
SPOTS: Players': 8 Alternates: 2
Mid-Players': 4 Alternates: 2
Senior Players': 3 Alternates: 2
TIES: In the event of a tie for the last qualifying spot and/or the alternate spot, there will be a hole-by-hole playoff immediately following play.
RULES: The USGA Rules of Golf, the MGA Rules Card, and the following local rules govern play. NOTE: Disregard any and all local rules printed on the local scorecard.
FORMAT: Two 9-hole rounds, stroke play. The MGA reserves the right to shorten the qualifying to 9 holes if, for any reason, the full 18 holes cannot be completed.
RULES TO NOTE: 4.3a(1) Distance and Directional Information. 10.2b(4) Restriction on Caddie Standing Behind Player. 12.2a Removing Loose Impediments and Movable Obstructions in Bunker. 13.1c Improvements Allowed on Putting Green. 13.2 No penalty for striking the flagstick. 14.3 Dropping Ball in Relief Area.
OUT OF BOUNDS: Course boundaries are defined by the following: White stake or lines and property fences.
PENALTY AREAS: Penalty Areas are defined by YELLOW stakes and/or lines. Lateral Penalty Areas are defined by RED stakes and/or lines.
DROPPING ZONE: Local Rule E-1.1 As an additional option for a ball in the penalty area behind #1 green and for relief from the penalty area and cart path, on hole #11 for a ball ending up past the green.
GROUND UNDER REPAIR: Areas circled by white lines are played as Ground Under Repair (GUR).
NO PLAY ZONE: All cultivated flower & shrubbery beds and areas marked with White/Green topped stakes are considered No Play Zones.
OBSTRUCTIONS: All artificially surfaced roads and paths including gravel and rock surfaced paths and roads and reasonable extensions thereof including their artificial borders.
PACE OF PLAY: The published MGA Pace of Play Policy is in effect.
RULES COMMITTEE: MGA Site Captain and any other MGA committee person.
