Local Rules & Information

- TEES: All players in the Players', Mid-Players' and Senior Players' Qualifier Divisions will play from the BLUE tees (approx. 6,291 yards).
SPOTS: Players': 1 Alternates: 2; Mid-Players': 1 Alternates: 2; Senior Players': 1 Alternates: 1
TIES: In the event of a tie for the last qualifying spot and/or the alternate spots, an announcement will be made as to the playoff procedure.
RULES: The Rules of Golf, the MGA Terms of Competition, Pace of Play Policy, and the following local rules govern play.
FORMAT: Two 9-hole rounds, stroke play.
ELECTRONIC SCORING: The official method of scoring will be electronic by use of the Golf Genius Mobile App.
OUT OF BOUNDS: Course boundaries are defined by the following: White stake or lines and property fences.
PENALTY AREAS: Penalty Areas are defined by either RED or YELLOW stakes and/or lines.
DROPPING ZONE: There are no dropping zones in use during the qualifier.
GROUND UNDER REPAIR: In addition to areas circled by white lines, the following areas are ground under repair: Model Local Rule F-7 - Ball in sod seams of newly sodded areas - lie of ball and area of intended swing only.
NO PLAY ZONE: All cultivated flower & shrubbery beds - mandatory relief, no penalty.
OBSTRUCTIONS: All artificially surfaced roads and paths including gravel and rock surfaced paths and roads and reasonable extensions thereof including their artificial borders.
PACE OF PLAY: The published MGA Pace of Play Policy is in effect.
