



6TH ANNUAL MINNESOTA YOUTH ON COURSE 100 HOLE HIKE FACT SHEET

GENERAL INFO

This year, we are hosting three Youth On Course Hikes here in the state of Minnesota with an ambitious goal of \$50,000 raised between all three hikes. These donations go toward subsidizing affordable \$5 golf in Minnesota, to help break down the cost barrier to play golf for kids ages 6 to 18.

2023 MN YOUTH ON COURSE MILESTONES

- 60,000 Rounds Played in 2023 so far as of 8/15
- 15,250 Active Members
- 100+ Participating Courses

MN YOUTH ON COURSE ALL TIME STATS

- 250,000 rounds played since 2018
- \$1.5 million spent in subsidies since 2018
- 57,000 members since 2018
- 50 MN YOC courses with over a thousand Youth On Course rounds played all time
- 15 MN YOC courses with over five thousand Youth On Course rounds played all time
- 4 MN YOC courses with over ten thousand Youth On Course rounds played all time

NATIONAL IMPACT STATS

- 85% of YOC families say YOC makes it possible to afford the cost of golf for their children
- 88% of members say YOC has helped them exercise more
- 82% of members say YOC has helped their family spend more time together
- 80% of members say YOC has helped them develop better social skills
- 80% of members say YOC has helped improve their confidence
