GOLDEN EAGLE GOLF CLUB & DEACON'S LODGE AUGUST 7-8, 2017 NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

FORM OF PLAY: All teams entered in the event will play 18 holes at Golden Eagle GC on August 7 and 18 holes at Deacon's Lodge on August 8. The two low scores for each team will be added together for each hole. The lowest 36 hole total team score will be the winner. Prizes will be awarded for low team scores, along with some proximity prizes.

<u>TEES:</u> Men will play from the BLUE tees, women will play from the RED tees and Sr. men (55 and older) will play from the WHITE tees. **If you are a senior male and want to move back to the BLUE tees, make sure to notify Joel by**Thursday, August 3. Handicaps will be adjusted to whatever tee you are playing from. The MGA uses section 3-5 in the handicap manual, which allows events to use different tees and appropriately adjust handicaps for men and women.

STARTING TIMES: Monday, August 7 - 1:00 p.m. at Golden Eagle GC & Tuesday, August 8 – 9:00 a.m. at Deacon's Lodge, please be ready to go in your cart 15 minutes before the shotgun.

<u>REGISTRATION</u>: Registration will begin 2 hours before the shotgun. When you arrive please check-in at registration to receive your information.

FACILITIES: The practice areas will be open at 2 hours before each shotgun.

LUNCHES: On both days there will be lunches available. At Golden Eagle GC a lunch will be available before the round, and at Deacon's Lodge a lunch will be available after the round.

FOOD & DRINK: Before and during golf, food/drink will be available for cash at the clubhouse or beverage carts.

HANDICAPS: As prescribed by the USGA Handicap System, 90% of men's handicaps and 95% of women's handicaps will be used. Women's handicaps will also be adjusted for the difference in men's and women's course ratings. The handicaps used will be as of the August 1st handicap index revision.

INDIVIDUAL SKINS: Optional individual skins will be available for players each day. \$10 for net, \$10 for gross or \$20 for both each day.

MGA DRESS CODE: For all MGA competitions, players must be neat in appearance with respect to personal grooming and clothing. All males are required to wear shirts with collars and sleeves, and either golf slacks or Bermuda shorts which measure no higher than 2 inches above their knees. All females are required to wear slacks, shorts, or golf skirts that are of appropriate length, and golf tops (sleeveless tops are permitted).

PLAYOFF: All ties will be determined by a scorecard playoff.

ETIQUETTE: Be sure to replace divots, rake bunkers and fix all ball marks on greens.
