NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

FORM OF PLAY: All teams entered in the event will play 18 holes at Owatonna CC on September 18. The two low scores for each team will be added together for each hole. The lowest 18 hole total team score will be the winner. Prizes will be awarded for low net and gross team scores, along with proximity prizes.

TEES: Men will play from the WHITE tees, women will play from the RED tees and Sr. men (55 and older) will play from the GREEN tees. **If you are a senior male and want to move back to the WHITE tees, make sure to notify Joel by Thursday, July 20.** Handicaps will be adjusted to whatever tee you are playing from. The MGA uses section 3-5 in the handicap manual, which allows events to use different tees and appropriately adjust handicaps for men and women.

White Tees – 6118 yards (Par 71)

Green Tees – 5686 yards (Par 71)

Red Tees – 5251 yards (Par 72)

FACILITIES: The practice areas and pro shop will be open at 11:00 a.m..

FOOD & DRINK: Before and during golf, food/drink will be available for cash at the clubhouse or beverage carts.

FOOD AFTER GOLF: Following the round there will be food and prize ceremony in the clubhouse. There will be a CASH bar. Once all scorecards are turned in, prizes will be awarded right away.

HANDICAPS: As prescribed by the USGA Handicap System, 90% of men's handicaps and 95% of women's handicaps will be used. Women's handicaps will also be adjusted for the difference in men's and women's course ratings. The handicaps used will be as of the September 15th handicap index revision.

MGA DRESS CODE: For all MGA competitions, players must be neat in appearance with respect to personal grooming and clothing. All males are required to wear shirts with collars and sleeves, and either golf slacks or Bermuda shorts which measure no higher than 2 inches above their knees. All females are required to wear slacks, shorts, or golf skirts that are of appropriate length, and golf tops (sleeveless tops are permitted).

PLAYOFF: All ties will be determined by a scorecard playoff.

ETIQUETTE: Be sure to replace divots, rake bunkers and fix all ball marks on greens.

REGISTRATION: Registration will begin 2 hours before the shotgun. When you arrive please check-in at registration to receive your information.

STARTING TIME: 1:00 p.m., please be ready to go in your cart 15 minutes before the shotgun.
