THE CLASSIC – MADDEN'S RESORT SEPTEMBER 16-17, 2018 NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

FORM OF PLAY: All teams entered in the event will play 18 holes at The Classic on September 16 and 18 holes at The Classic on September 17. The two low scores for each team will be added together for each hole. The lowest 36 hole total team score will be the winner. Prizes will be awarded for low team scores, along with some proximity prizes.

<u>TEES:</u> Men will play from the BLUE tees, women will play from the RED tees and Sr. men (55 and older) will play from the WHITE tees. **If you are a senior male and want to move back to the BLUE tees, make sure to notify Joel by**Wednesday, September 12. Handicaps will be adjusted to whatever tee you are playing from. The MGA uses section 3-5 in the handicap manual, which allows events to use different tees and appropriately adjust handicaps for men and women.

STARTING TIMES: Sunday, September 16 – Tee times starting at 12:00 p.m. – Check pairings for your starting time. Monday, September 17 – 9:00 a.m. Shotgun, please be ready to go in your cart 15 minutes before the shotgun.

REGISTRATION: Registration will begin 1hour before your starting time in the clubhouse. When you arrive please check-in at registration to receive your information.

FACILITIES: The practice areas will be open 1 hour before.

FOOD & DRINK: Before and during golf, food/drink will be available for cash at the clubhouse or beverage carts. The MGA will buy each group drinks after the first round.

HANDICAPS: As prescribed by the USGA Handicap System, 90% of men's handicaps and 95% of women's handicaps will be used. Women's handicaps will also be adjusted for the difference in men's and women's course ratings. The handicaps used will be as of the September 1st handicap index revision.

MGA DRESS CODE: For all MGA competitions, players must be neat in appearance with respect to personal grooming and clothing. All males are required to wear shirts with collars and sleeves, and either golf slacks or Bermuda shorts which measure no higher than 2 inches above their knees. All females are required to wear slacks, shorts, or golf skirts that are of appropriate length, and golf tops (sleeveless tops are permitted).

PLAYOFF: All ties will be determined by a scorecard playoff.

ETIQUETTE: Be sure to replace divots, rake bunkers and fix all ball marks on greens.
