ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to amateur female golfers who meet the requirements under Handicap Regulations and Limitations, and who are in good standing with the MWGA.

HANDICAP REGULATIONS AND LIMITATIONS

- 1. Only a USGA Handicap Index computed under the MGA Handicap Program is acceptable.
- 2. The handicap as of the July 15 handicap revision date will be used for tournament eligibility and flight placement.
- 3. MWGA entrant's current handicap index shall not exceed 36.0. Non-MWGA entrant's current handicap index shall not exceed 4.4.

FIELD LIMITATIONS

The field will be limited to 144 players. Ties in handicap indexes for the last position will be settled by blind draw. If the field is oversubscribed, an alternate list will be developed. Applicants on the alternate list will be notified.

MON-JULY 27: First Round - 18 holes of stroke play.

TUE-JULY 28: Second Round - 18 holes of stroke play.

WED-JULY 29: Final Round - 18 holes of stroke play.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

FLIGHTS

Players with handicap indexes of 4.4 or less shall play in the Championship Flight. Adapted in 2013, MWGA MEMBERS with a USGA handicap index 4.5 and above may elect to play in the Championship Flight. All other players shall be placed in flights according to their handicap indexes.

CHAMPION

The Champion shall be the player in the Championship Flight having the low gross score for 54 holes. Ties shall be played off immediately in a unit of three holes. If the players are still tied, there shall be a sudden death play-off until the Champion is determined.

TROPHY AND PRIZES

The Champion shall be presented the Championship Trophy which shall be in her possession for the ensuing year with the stipulation that the trophy shall remain in the State of Minnesota. Medals and gift certificates shall be awarded as determined by The Committee

The Mildred Hagman Trophy will be presented to the medalist, the player with the lowest gross score in the qualifying round. This trophy shall be in her possession for the ensuing year with the stipulation that the trophy shall remain in the State of Minnesota.

TEAM EVENT (Ann Cargill Trophy)

In the first round of play, a team consisting of three members from an individual club is eligible to compete for the team trophy. The team must be registered with the MWGA tournament committee before the first player of the team leaves the first tee. The lowest total net score of each team will determine the winner. Ties will be decided by matching scorecards as defined by the USGA.

The Ann Cargill Trophy will be presented to the winners of the team event to be in their possession for the ensuing year with the stipulation that the trophy remain in the State of Minnesota.

MWGA DRESS CODE POLICY WILL BE ENFORCED MWGA Dress Code Policy can be found on page 8.

Tournament entries are subject to approval or rejection at any time (either before or during the tournament) by The Committee at its discretion. All play is in accordance with the USGA Rules of Golf. All decisions by The Committee in any matter concerning this tournament shall be final.
