GENERAL INFORMATION

Eligibility

Entries are open to female amateur golfers who: (1) are currently a Member of the MGA at the club from which they are playing, (2) whose club is a current member of the MGA, (3) whose active handicap index at the time of registration does not exceed 12.4, and (4) are at least 25 years of age as of August 7, 2016.

Championship Format

All players in the Championship will play 36 holes of stroke play. The Champion will be the player with the lowest total gross score after 36 holes. A tie for the overall championship will be played off immediately, hole by hole, until a champion is determined.

Flights will be determined based on the August 1 handicap revision. Prizes will be awarded to each flight, however, regardless of flight, all players will be playing from the same set of tee markers, thus making everyone eligible to win the overall Championship.

Dress Code

For all MGA competitions, players and caddies must be neat in appearance with respect to personal grooming and clothing. All entrants are required to wear either slacks, shorts or golf skirts/skorts that are of appropriate length, and golf tops (sleeveless tops are permitted). Examples of attire NOT ACCEPTABLE includes the following: short shorts, athletic shorts, tennis shorts, cut-offs, jeans, jean shorts, tank tops, t-shirts and sweats. The Committee will decide whether this requirement has been met and will withdraw the entry of any player not complying.

Contestants are responsible for paying the appropriate fee for the use of such carts prior to play each day.
