



YOC Member Code of Conduct

The safety and well-being of our members are Youth on Course's top priority. Our standards and expectations exist to ensure that every member of Youth on Course feels safe and welcome whenever they visit a golf course to play. Please remember, when you are playing at a YOC facility, you are representing yourself, your family, and the entire Youth on Course community.

Expectations of YOC members include:

- Be respectful to yourself
- Be respectful to others, including golf course staff members, and your playing partners
- Be respectful to the course and any of the course's buildings, grounds, & equipment
- Follow the rules of each course you visit. YOC availability varies and can be viewed in the YOC app or on the website. Course policies like tee-time booking and dress code may be found on each course's website.
- Play fairly and be honest
- Resolve disagreements in a positive way
- Avoid inappropriate language
- YOC memberships are for individuals only. Sharing a YOC membership with someone else is not allowed
- Usage of drugs or alcohol is prohibited

Disciplinary Actions & Consequences

Minor infractions are handled on a case-by-case basis, with disciplinary actions taken as necessary. All disciplinary issues will be handled on an individual basis. Members who do not follow the YOC Member Code of Conduct can expect to be contacted by Youth on Course Headquarters. Depending on the degree of the infraction, members may lose privileges.

Disciplinary actions may include, but are not limited to the following:

- Verbal coaching/re-teaching behavior
- Community service projects
- Suspension of Youth on Course membership
- Expulsion (i.e. permanent suspension – membership revoked)
- Contacting the proper authorities
